

- 30 Credits (17 Compulsory, 13 Elective)
- 40 Hours of Community Involvement
- Successful completion of the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test
- Earn at least 2 Online Learning Credits

### What do you need to graduate

from high school?

#### **17 Compulsory Credits**

Students must earn the following compulsory credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma:

3	Mathematics (Grade 9, Grade 10 and 1 Credit in Grade 11 or 12)	
2	Science	
1	Canadian Geography (Grade 9)	
1	French as a Second Language

1	Arts (Drama, Music, Visual Arts, Media Arts)	
0.5	Career Studies	
0.5	Civics and Citizenship	
1	Technological Education	
1	STEM Related Course Group

	Mathematics (In addition to the 3 compulsory credits)	
	Science (In addition to the 2 compulsory credits)	
	Technological Education (In addition to the 1 compulsory credit)	

- 1 30 credits in total
- 2 40 hours of Community
- 3 Completion of the Literacy Requirement
- Earn at least 2 Online Learning Credits

#### In addition, students must complete:

/	13 elective credits
/	40 hours of community involvement activities
/	the provincial literacy requirement

Starting in September 2025, you must earn a new financial literacy graduation requirement as part of your compulsory Grade 10 Mathematics Course.

You will need to achieve a mark of 70% or higher to pass this new requirement.

#### The following apply to compulsory credit selections

- The Grade 11 English: Understanding Contemporary First Nations, Métis and Inuit Voices course to meet the Grade 11 English compulsory credit requirement.
- You can use the Grade 9 Expressions of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Cultures course to meet the compulsory credit requirement in the arts.
- You must earn 13 optional credits by successfully completing courses from your school's program and course calendar.
- Optional credits may include up to 4 credits earned through approved dual credit programs.

### **Roles of Inclusive Student Services @ Henry**

- Attend all IPRC meetings/yearly reviews
- Maintenance of Individual Education Plan (IEP)
