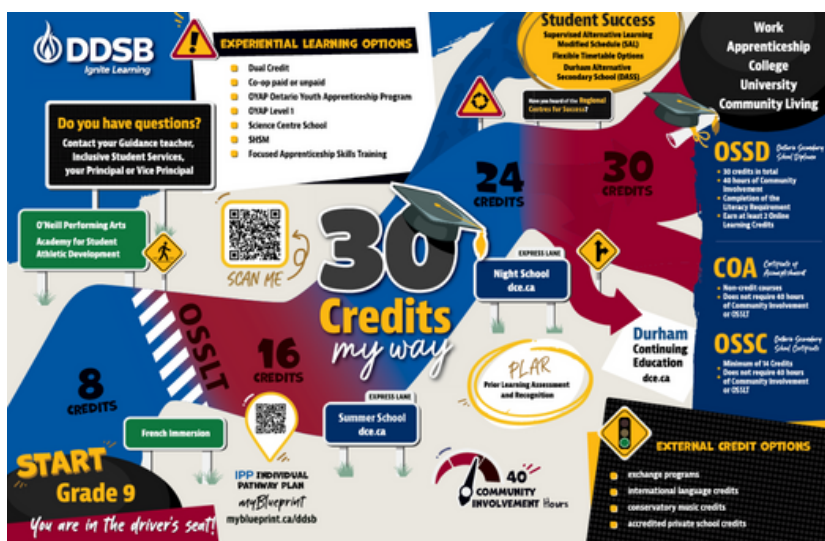
30 Credits My Way – Family Webinar

Teachers do their best to respond promptly, so don't hesitate to reach out with any questions or concerns.

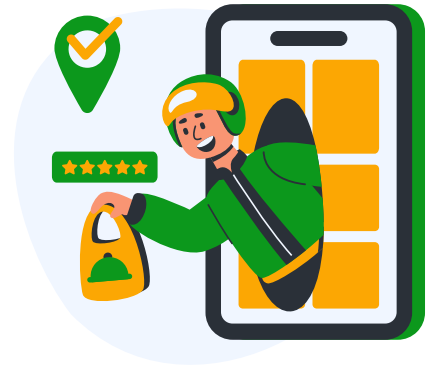

For Current Grade 11 Students!

Applications for the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program for students to start a Skilled Trade Apprenticeship while still in Grade 12 will come out in February, 2026. Applications are available from the Cooperative Education Counsellors Ms. Parrington and Mrs. Feliciano.

There will be "Lunch and Learn" sessions as well to learn how to apply successfully. Apprenticeships available for applications are: Automotive Service Technician, Carpentry, Construction Craft Worker (at LiUNA in Cobourg) Cook/Chef, Electrician, Hairstyling, Industrial Mechanic/Millwright, Plumbing, and Welding. These are highly competitive and demand a strong success in pre-requisite courses, excellent high school attendance and punctuality, and some aptitude/experience/course completion in the apprenticeship of interest.

This fee is required to attend Rivalry Week and Grad Formal.

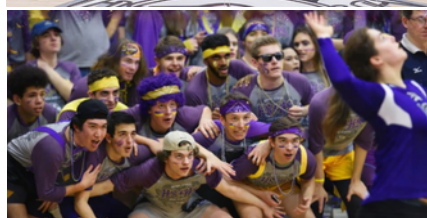

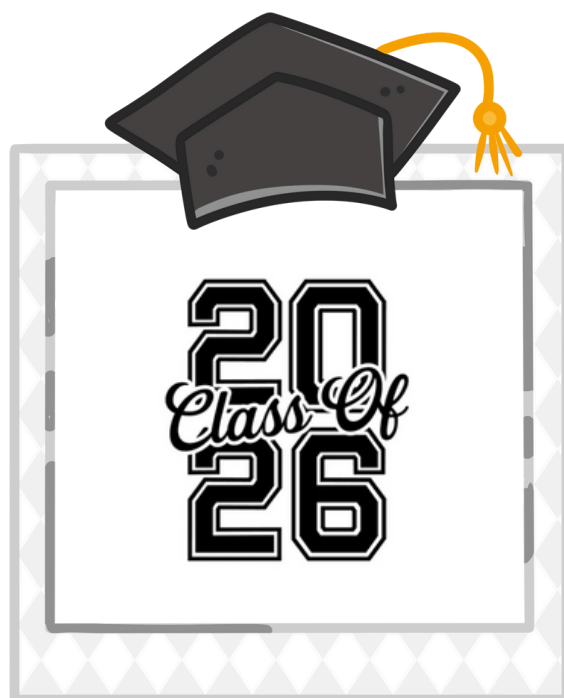

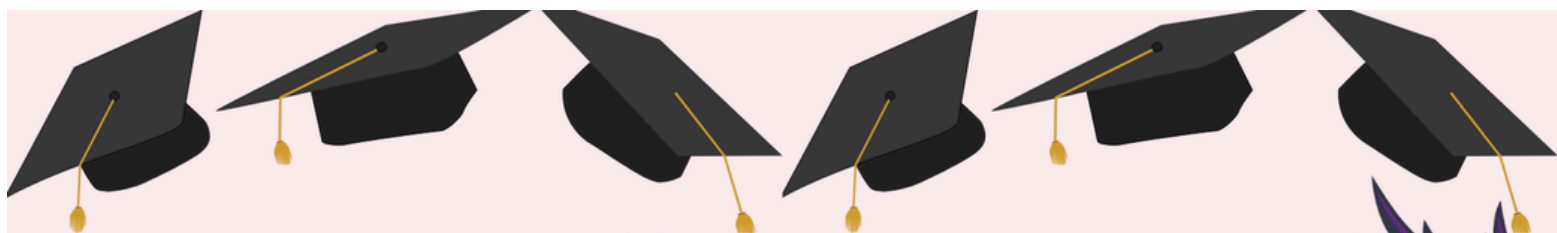
