AGREEMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Camp is intended to develop leadership skills; however it is also considered a reward for previous leadership in the school. As such, students who have applied for camp must uphold all attributes and reflect all qualities that leadership camp represents. These include, but are not exclusive to: contributing positively to the school environment, displaying leadership qualities, abiding by all school rules and procedures and the school code of conduct (see the Student Agenda for all rules and the Code of Conduct), and maintaining good academic standing. If the conduct of those students who wish to attend camp does not meet the preceding standard, as deemed by the leadership camp teacher advisors upon consultation with Henry Street staff, the applicant will lose the opportunity to attend camp.

In addition, students and parents must acknowledge and understand of some serious rules while attending camp. These include, but are not exclusive to: bringing prohibited materials to camp (tobacco products, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapourizers, cannabis, other drugs, alcohol), the use of these prohibited items at camp, adherence to curfew hours imposed by staff and the camp itself, appropriate use of mobile phones while at camp (i.e. preferably not brought to camp at all, but if absolutely necessary then not brought out of camper rooms and no posting on social media any materials related to the camp weekend). Please see info package for further details on these serious rules. Parents must acknowledge that they will be willing and ready to pick up their student from camp if the above aforementioned “serious rules” are not adhered to by a camper.

Further, an applicant may be removed if he/she is not deemed physically able (e.g. illness, injury, etc.) by the teacher supervisor(s) to participate in camp activities and/or puts other campers’ health and safety at risk.

In either case listed above, or if an applicant does not attend camp for any other reason (e.g. sports related, etc.) or is removed from camp or departs camp early, a deposit will only be refunded if there is another applicant available on the waiting list to replace the removed applicant. If there is no applicant on the waiting list, the deposit will be refunded less the expenses already incurred for the removed applicant’s material/supplies. Removal of an applicant may occur at any time, even after payment has been made if a applicant fails to meet leadership camp criteria.

For whatever reason, if an applicant decides he/she can no longer attend camp, he/she must let the supervising teachers know prior to Wednesday, April 24, 2019. If an applicant does not notify the supervising teachers by that date, no refund can be given as all arrangements and payments for the applicant have been made.

Finally, students will be kept informed using the “Remind” text messaging service, please feel free to sign up for this service along with your student to keep informed about Camp information. By registering for “Remind” text messages and/or returning camp permission forms, parents/guardians approve to keeping informed by this service.

NOTE : Approval of Camp application means a signature from either Ms. Hines, Ms. McIntyre, Ms. Maillet (Ibsen) or Mr. Loveless to indicate that your application is satisfactory, at which point they will write the date/time of submission; order of acceptance will determine order of preference to be eligible for reserving a spot to attend camp. You may be required to clarify aspects of your application or expand further upon the application, at camp supervisor's discretion. For those returning campers, an emphasis is placed on what they have done differently since attending camp. For new campers the emphasis is on leadership demonstrated within the school. You will be notified of the success of your application when you receive your invitation (you will either receive an invitation, a conditional invitation or no invitation).

Important Information and Other Requirements:

1. Submit Monday, December 2nd by 3:15pm to Mr. Loveless in room 210, Ms. McIntyre in the Science Office, Ms. Maillet (Ibsen) in the Math Office, or Ms. Hines in Academic Resource (room 206).
2. Grade 9 and 10 students might be nominated by their teachers to attend camp, however are welcome to complete this application form to attend camp regardless of teacher nomination.
3. Applications must be submitted either before school (prior to 8:55), after school (after 3:05) or at lunch (11: 40 to 12:30). **Applications will not be accepted during class time.**
4. Please be sure to **complete all parts of this application;** if important information is missing, we will not be able to accept the application.
5. Leadership Council teacher advisors reserve the right to re-evaluate your camp eligibility if new information questioning your leadership potential or behaviour is presented at any time.
6. Our intention is to invite eligible students to an information assembly on December 18. Please be aware that there is a maximum camp attendance; this means that not everyone is able to attend. Camp is April 23rd to 26th, 2020. (Please don't apply if you are unable to attend on those days).
7. There are 3 possible outcomes of this application that you must be aware of:
 - a. Your application is approved and you will receive a camp invitation for the Kickoff Assembly on Dec 18.
 - b. Your application is **not approved**, you will not receive an invitation to the information assembly.
